CONFERENCE WILL TRY TO PERSUADE HANOI
TO STOP PEOPLE LEAVING : GOVERNOR

* * * * *

THE GOVERNOR, SIR DAVID WILSON, SAID ONE OF THE OBJECTIVES OF THE INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE ON INDO-CHINESE REFUGEES IN GENEVA IS TO PERSUADE THE VIETNAMESE GOVERNMENT TO STOP THEIR OWN PEOPLE LEAVING AND PUT THEIR OWN HOUSE IN ORDER.

SPEAKING IN A DOCUMENTARY FILM ON VIETNAMESE BOAT PEOPLE PRODUCED BY RTHK FOR SCREENING ON LOCAL TELEVISION TONIGHT (MONDAY), THE GOVERNOR SAID ANOTHER OBJECTIVE OF THE CONFERENCE WAS TO TRY TO MAKE SURE THAT HONG KONG GOT MUCH MORE SUBSTANTIAL RESETTLEMENT OFFERS FROM ALL ROUND THE WORLD.

ALSO, THE GOVERNMENT WANTED ARRANGEMENTS PUT IN PLACE FOR PEOPLE WERE SCREENED OUT AS ECONOMIC MIGRANTS TO GO BACK TO THEIR OWN COUNTRY, HE ADDED.

COMMENTING ON A SUGGESTION THAT THE FIRST ASYLUM POLICY SHOULD BE ABOLISHED, SIR DAVID SAID IT WAS VERY EASY SOMETIMES TO SAY BUT IT WAS NOT REALLY AS SIMPLE AS THAT.

"IN PRACTICE, YOU ARE DEALING WITH PEOPLE IN THESE TINY LITTLE BOATS - - - UNSEAWORTHY, TRYING TO GET IN HERE.

"WE ARE AT THE END OF THE LINE, WE'RE NOT LIKE SINGAPORE WHICH CAN SIMPLY SAY GO ON, INDONESIA IS AROUND THE CORNER, OR MALAYSIA IS AROUND THE CORNER, WE ARE THE END OF THE LINE," HE SAID.

THE GOVERNOR SAID IF HONG KONG STOPPED PEOPLE COMING IN, WE HAD A HIGH RISK THAT THEY WOULD SIMPLY TRY TO COME IN ANYHOW. "SO THAT IS A PRACTICAL PROBLEM," HE SAID.

SIR DAVID ALSO POINTED OUT THAT HONG KONG HAD TO CONSIDER ITSELF AS PART OF THE WORLD, AND WE HAD TO CONSIDER THE WAY THE WORLD REACTED TO WHAT WE DID HERE.

"SO GIVING UP FIRST ASYLUM IS A PHRASE WHICH SOUNDS TERRIBLY SIMPLE, BUT IN PRACTICE IT ISN'T THAT SIMPLE," HE ADDED.

THE GOVERNOR SAID HE WAS ENCOURAGED BY WHAT THE FOREIGN SECRETARY, SIR GEOFFREY HOWE, HAD SAID BECAUSE IT SHOWED THE BRITISH GOVERNMENT WAS FULLY AWARE OF THE SERIOUSNESS OF THE PROBLEM.

"AND IN THE SAME WAY, THE FACT THAT MRS THATCHER CHOSE THIS AS ONE OF THE VERY FEW WORLD SUBJECTS THAT SHE WANTED TO DISCUSS WITH PRESIDENT BUSH SHOWS THAT THE BRITISH GOVERNMENT REALLY IS TAKING THE PROBLEM SERIOUSLY, AND THAT IS ENCOURAGING," HE SAID.

SDA TO VISIT JAPAN

THE SECRETARY FOR DISTRICT ADMINISTRATION, MR DONALD LIAO, WILL VISIT JAPAN FROM TOMORROW (TUESDAY) TO FRIDAY (JUNE 16).

MR LIAO WILL HAVE DISCUSSIONS WITH JAPANESE BUSINESSMEN AND OFFICIALS ON INFRASTRUCTURAL DEVELOPMENTS IN HONG KONG, AND ON ARRANGEMENTS FOR THE TERRITORY IN THE RUN-UP TO 1997.

ON WEDNESDAY (JUNE 14), MR LIAO WILL MEET MEMBERS OF THE JAPAN/HONG KONG BUSINESS COOPERATION COMMITTEE AND OFFICIALS OF THE MINISTRY OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS.

THE NEXT DAY, HE WILL DELIVER A SPEECH IN JAPANESE ENTITLED "HONG KONG : TOWARDS 1997" AT A JAPAN/HONG KONG SOCIETY LUNCHEON MEETING.

BEFORE WINDING UP HIS VISIT ON FRIDAY, MR LIAO WILL HAVE DISCUSSIONS WITH JAPANESE TRADE AND FOREIGN AFFAIRS OFFICIALS.

HOTLINE TO CEASE AT 5 PM TODAY

A GOVERNMENT SPOKESMAN ANNOUNCED THAT THE GOVERNMENT HOTLINE TO ASSIST HONG KONG RESIDENTS STRANDED IN PEKING WILL CEASE TO OPERATE FROM 5 PM TODAY (MONDAY).

THE 24-HOUR HOTLINE WAS SET UP ON THE EVENING OF LAST MONDAY (JUNE 5) TO DEAL WITH REQUESTS FOR ASSISTANCE FROM FRIENDS AND RELATIVES OF HONG KONG RESIDENTS WHO MIGHT HAVE BEEN STRANDED IN PEKING FOR ONE REASON OR ANOTHER.

DURING THE WEEK, NO FEWER THAN 800 CALLS WERE RECEIVED BY THE HOTLINE UNIT, 709 OF WHICH RELATED TO HONG KONG RESIDENTS IN PEKING.

INFORMATION GATHERED WAS PASSED TO THE BRITISH EMBASSY IN PEKING. THE EMBASSY THEN CONTACTED AS MANY PEOPLE AS THEY COULD TO OFFER ADVICE AND ASSISTANCE.

THE HOTLINE UNIT HAS ASCERTAINED THAT 527 PEOPLE HAVE EITHER RETURNED TO HONG KONG OR ARE CONFIRMED TO HAVE LEFT PEKING.

THREE SPECIAL FLIGHTS BY DRAGONAIR WHICH WERE CHARTERED BY THE HONG KONG GOVERNMENT ON JUNE 5, 6, AND 7 BROUGHT BACK A TOTAL OF 252 PEOPLE THROUGH THE ASSISTANCE OF THE BRITISH EMBASSY IN PEKING.

THE EMBASSY STAFF HAVE ALSO OFFERED A GREAT DEAL OF ASSISTANCE IN ARRANGING FOR HONG KONG RESIDENTS TO BOARD NOT ONLY THE CHARTERED FLIGHTS BUT ALSO SCHEDULED FLIGHTS AND EXTRA SECTIONS OF FLIGHTS OPERATED BY THE AIRLINE COMPANIES AT THE HONG KONG GOVERNMENT'S SPECIAL REQUEST.

REGIONAL SECRETARY SEES DEVELOPMENTS ON ISLANDS

THE REGIONAL SECRETARY FOR THE NEW TERRITORIES, MR ADOLF HSU, VISITED LANTAU ISLAND AND PENG CHAU TODAY (MONDAY) AND DISCUSSED MATTERS OF GENERAL INTEREST WITH MEMBERS OF THE ISLANDS DISTRICT BOARD.

MR HSU, ACCOMPANIED BY THE DISTRICT BOARD CHAIRMAN, MR LAM WAI-KEUNG, DISTRICT OFFICER, MR JONATHAN NG, AND SENIOR STAFF OF THE DISTRICT OFFICE, WENT TO LANTAU IN THE MORNING.

AT MUI WO, HE TOURED THE NGAN WAN ESTATE, WHICH WAS THE THIRD RURAL PUBLIC HOUSING ESTATE TO BE BUILT IN THE DISTRICT. THE ESTATE PROVIDES OVER 460 FLATS FOR ABOUT 1,650 PEOPLE.

HE TOOK A PANORAMIC VIEW OF THE PARTLY COMPLETED MUI WO PACKAGE DEVELOPMENT FROM THE ROOF OF THE ESTATE AND LEARNT THAT PROJECTS SUCH AS THE REGIONAL COUNCIL COMPLEX, A SWIMMING POOL/SPORTS COMPLEX, A GOVERNMENT BUILDING AND A SPORTS GROUND WERE IN THE PIPELINE.

THE PARTY LATER PROCEEDED TO PENG CHAU AND VISITED THE RECENTLY CONSTRUCTED WATERFRONT PLAYGROUND THERE.

MR HSU WAS ALSO BRIEFED ON PLANS TO BUILD A COMBINED LIBRARY AND INDOOR RECREATIONAL CENTRE, A FIRE STATION AND A SECONDARY SCHOOL ON THE ISLAND.

THE YUEN LONG DISTRICT BOARD WILL HOLD A SPECIAL MEETING TOMORROW (TUESDAY) TO DISCUSS THE GOVERNMENT'S DECISION TO TURN PART OF THE RUNWAY AT RAF SEK KONG IN PAT HEUNG INTO A CLOSED DETENTION CENTRE FOR SOME 7,000 VIETNAMESE BOAT PEOPLE.

A REPRESENTATIVE OF THE SECURITY BRANCH WILL BE PRESENT TO EXPLAIN THE NEW MEASURE.

THE PAT HEUNG RURAL COMMITTEE EARLIER EXPRESSED CONCERN THAT THE NEW DETENTION CENTRE WILL POSE A SECURITY PROBLEM TO NEARBY VILLAGERS.

STORAGE IN HONG KONG'S RESERVOIRS AT 9 AM TODAY (MONDAY) STOOD AT 53.8 PER CENT OF CAPACITY OR 315.069 MILLION CUBIC METRES.

THIS TIME LAST YEAR THE RESERVOIRS CONTAINED 155.011 MILLION CUBIC METRES OF WATER, REPRESENTING 26.4 PER CENT OF CAPACITY.

SUMMARY RESULTS OF 1987 SURVEY OF INDUSTRIAL PRODUCTION
* * * * *

THE CENSUS AND STATISTICS DEPARTMENT RELEASED TODAY (MONDAY) SUMMARY STATISTICS COMPILED FROM THE SURVEY OF INDUSTRIAL PRODUCTION COVERING THE REFERENCE YEAR 1987. FIELD WORK FOR THE SURVEY WAS UNDERTAKEN BETWEEN MAY LAST YEAR AND EARLY THIS YEAR.

THE SURVEY RESULTS INDICATED THAT 50,756 MANUFACTURING ESTABLISHMENTS HAD OPERATED FOR THE WHOLE OR PART OF 1987.

THE YEAR 1987 WAS PROSPEROUS FOR THE MANUFACTURING SECTOR. THE VALUE OF GROSS OUTPUT IN THE SECTOR DURING 1987 WAS ESTIMATED AT \$283,340 MILLION, REPRESENTING A SUBSTANTIAL INCREASE OF 24.7 PER CENT IN MONEY TERMS COMPARED WITH 1986.

THE EXPENSES OF MANUFACTURING ESTABLISHMENTS IN 1987 INCLUDED \$189,322 MILLION ON THE PURCHASES OF MATERIALS, SUPPLIES AND INDUSTRIAL WORK/SERVICES; \$45,569 MILLION ON COMPENSATION OF EMPLOYEES; AND \$24,229 MILLION ON OTHER EXPENSES.

THE TOTAL VALUE ADDED OF THE MANUFACTURING SECTOR STOOD AT \$75,761 MILLION IN 1987, REPRESENTING A SUBSTANTIAL INCREASE OF 20.7 PER CENT IN MONEY TERMS COMPARED WITH 1986. VALUE ADDED IS A MEASURE OF THE NET OUTPUT OF THE SECTOR AND REFLECTS THE SECTOR'S CONTRIBUTION TO HONG KONG'S GROSS DOMESTIC PRODUCT.

RANKED ACCORDING TO THEIR VALUE ADDED, THE TOP FIVE BROAD INDUSTRY GROUPS WITHIN THE MANUFACTURING SECTOR IN HONG KONG WERE : WEARING APPAREL (\$17,835 MILLION OR 24 PER CENT OF THE TOTAL VALUE ADDED OF THE MANUFACTURING SECTOR); TEXTILES (\$12,578 MILLION OR 17 PER CENT); BASIC METALS, FABRICATED METAL PRODUCTS, MACHINERY AND EQUIPMENT (\$12,539 MILLION OR 17 PER CENT); ELECTRICAL AND ELECTRONIC PRODUCTS (\$11,570 MILLION OR 15 PER CENT); AND PLASTIC PRODUCTS (\$6,064 MILLION OR 8 PER CENT).

THE PRINCIPAL STATISTICS FOR THE MANUFACTURING SECTOR, ANALYSED BY BROAD INDUSTRY GROUPS, ARE SHOWN IN THE ACCOMPANYING TABLE.

AS REGARDS THE GEOGRAPHICAL LOCATION OF MANUFACTURING ESTABLISHMENTS, THE MOST IMPORTANT AREAS WERE "TSUEN WAN, KWAI CHUNG, TSING YI" AND "NGAU TAU KOK, KWUN TONG, LEI YUE MUN". ESTABLISHMENTS IN THESE LOCATIONS ALTOGETHER ACCOUNTED FOR 48 PER CENT AND 46 PER CENT RESPECTIVELY OF THE GROSS OUTPUT AND VALUE ADDED OF THE MANUFACTURING SECTOR.

WHEN ANALYSED BY THE EMPLOYMENT SIZES OF MANUFACTURING ESTABLISHMENTS, THE STATISTICS SHOWED THAT ABOUT 66 PER CENT OF THE TOTAL NUMBER OF MANUFACTURING ESTABLISHMENTS WERE ENGAGING FEWER THAN 10 PERSONS, BUT THESE SMALL ESTABLISHMENTS ONLY ACCOUNTED FOR 8 PER CENT, 9 PER CENT AND 13 PER CENT RESPECTIVELY OF THE GROSS OUTPUT, VALUE ADDED AND TOTAL WORKFORCE OF THE MANUFACTURING SECTOR.

IN CONTRAST, ONLY ABOUT 3 PER CENT OF THE TOTAL NUMBER OF MANUFACTURING ESTABLISHMENTS WERE ENGAGING 100 OR MORE PERSONS, BUT THEY CONTRIBUTED ABOUT 50 PER CENT OF THE SECTOR'S GROSS OUTPUT, 49 PER CENT OF VALUE ADDED AND EMPLOYED ABOUT 42 PER CENT OF THE TOTAL WORKFORCE.

THE 1987 SURVEY OF INDUSTRIAL PRODUCTION WAS ONE IN A SERIES OF ANNUAL INDUSTRIAL SURVEYS CONDUCTED BY THE CENSUS AND STATISTICS DEPARTMENT FOR ASCERTAINING THE STRUCTURE AND OPERATING CHARACTERISTICS OF THE RELEVANT SECTORS COVERED, AND ESTIMATING THEIR CONTRIBUTION TO THE GROSS DOMESTIC PRODUCT OF HONG KONG. APART FROM THE MANUFACTURING SECTOR, THE SURVEY ALSO COVERED ESTABLISHMENTS ENGAGED IN MINING AND QUARRYING AND IN THE SUPPLY OF ELECTRICITY, GAS AND WATER.

SUMMARY STATISTICS FOR THE 1987 SURVEY OF INDUSTRIAL PRODUCTION WILL BE INCLUDED IN THE JUNE 1989 ISSUE OF THE HONG KONG MONTHLY DIGEST OF STATISTICS PUBLISHED BY THE CENSUS AND STATISTICS DEPARTMENT.

THE SHA TIN DISTRICT BOARD'S TRAFFIC AND TRANSPORT COMMITTEE WILL MEET TOMORROW (TUESDAY) TO DISCUSS A BUS ROUTE DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME FOR 1989-90.

THE MEETING WILL ALSO DISCUSS THE EFFECTIVENESS OF REMEDIAL WORKS WHICH HAVE BEEN CARRIED OUT ON SIX PEDESTRIAN POINTS.

A MEMBER WILL ASK THE KOWLOON-CANTON RAILWAY CORPORATION IF IMPROVEMENTS WILL BE MADE ON ITS ESCALATORS AND VENTILATION FACILITIES.
