COUNTRY AND COMMODITY BREAKDOWN FIGURES
FOR AIRBORNE MERCHANDISE TRADE IN 1981

* * * *

AIRBORNE MERCHANDISE TRADE IN 1981 WAS VALUED AT \$57 001 MILLION, REPRESENTING AN INCREASE OF 23 PER CENT OVER 1980.

AIRBORNE DOMESTIC EXPORTS WERE VALUED AT \$21 344 MILLION (UP 25 PER CENT), AIRBORNE IMPORTS AT \$25 665 MILLION (UP 23 PER CENT), AND AIRBORNE RE-EXPORTS AT \$9 991 MILLION (UP 21 PER CENT).

IN 1981, 27 PER CENT BY VALUE OF TOTAL DOMESTIC EXPORTS, 19 PER CENT OF TOTAL IMPORTS AND 24 PER CENT OF TOTAL RE-EXPORTS WERE DESPATCHED BY AIR.

SUMMARY TRADE STATISTICS ON AIRBORNE MERCHANDISE TRADE IN 1981 WERE RELEASED BY THE CENSUS AND STATISTICS DEPARTMENT TODAY.

THE FOLLOWING TABLE ILLUSTRATES THE RELATIVE IMPORTANCE OF THE SIX MAJOR MARKETS FOR HONG KONG'S AIRBORNE DOMESTIC EXPORTS:-

BY COMMODITY, INCREASES IN AIRBORNE DOMESTIC EXPORTS WERE REGISTERED MAINLY IN CLOTHING (BY \$1 898 MILLION OR 38 PER CENT), PARTS AND ACCESSORIES OF OFFICE MACHINES AND DATA PROCESSING MACHINES, INCLUDING ELECTRONIC COMPONENTS (BY \$607 MILLION OR 45 PER CENT) AND WATCHES AND CLOCKS (BY \$490 MILLION OR NINE PER CENT).

HOWEVER, DECLINES WERE RECORDED FOR SCRAP AND SWEEPINGS OF PRECIOUS METALS (OTHER THAN OF GOLD) (BY \$179 MILLION OR 53 PER CENT) AS WELL AS THERMIONIC, COLD CATHODE AND PHOTO-CATHODE VALVES AND TUBES, PHOTOCELLS AND TRANSISTORS (BY \$197 MILLION OR 14 PER CENT).

FURTHER ANALYSIS OF COMMODITY BY COUNTRY REVEALED SIGNIFICANT GROWTH IN AIRBORNE DOMESTIC EXPORTS OF CLOTHING TO THE USA (BY \$1 180 MILLION OR 56 PER CENT), JAPAN (BY \$384 MILLION OR 98 PER CENT) AND CANADA (BY \$88 MILLION OR 41 PER CENT); IN AIRBORNE DOMESTIC EXPORTS OF WATCHES AND CLOCKS TO THE USA (BY \$251 MILLION OR 18 PER CENT) AND SAUDI ARABIA (BY \$205 MILLION OR 119 PER CENT); AND IN AIRBORNE DOMESTIC EXPORTS OF PARTS AND ACCESSORIES OF OFFICE MACHINES AND DATA PROCESSING MACHINES, INCLUDING ELECTRONIC COMPONENTS, TO THE USA (BY \$638 MILLION OR 54 PER CENT).

INCREASES WERE REGISTERED IN AIRBORNE IMPORTS OF WATCHES AND CLOCKS (BY \$1 360 MILLION OR 25 PER CENT), THERMIONIC, COLD CATHODE AND PHOTO-CATHODE VALVES AND TUBES, PHOTOCELLS AND TRANSISTORS (BY \$798 MILLION OR 26 PER CENT), AS WELL AS PEARLS, PRECIOUS AND SEMI-PRECIOUS STONES (BY \$672 MILLION OR 33 PER CENT). IN CONTRAST, DECREASES WERE NOTED IN THE SUPPLY, BY AIR, OF PARTS AND ACCESSORIES OF OFFICE MACHINES AND DATA PROCESSING MACHINES (BY \$100 MILLION OR SIX PER CENT), AS WELL AS AIRCRAFT AND ASSOCIATED EQUIPMENT (BY \$414 MILLION OR 44 PER CENT).

INCREASES WERE RECORDED IN AIRBORNE IMPORTS OF WATCHES AND CLOCKS FROM JAPAN (BY \$843 MILLION OR 40 PER CENT) AND THE REPUBLIC OF KOREA (BY \$316 MILLION OR 96 PER CENT). AMONG THE SIX MAJOR SUPPLIERS, THE USA WAS THE LARGEST SUPPLIER, BY AIR, OF PEARLS, PRECIOUS AND SEMI-PRECIOUS STONES, SHOWING AN INCREASE OF \$218 MILLION OR 115 PER CENT. GROWTH WAS ALSO RECORDED IN AIRBORNE IMPORTS OF THERMIONIC, COLD CATHODE AND PHOTO-CATHODE VALVES AND TUBES, PHOTOCELLS AND TRANSISTORS FROM TAIWAN (BY \$168 MILLION OR 85 PER CENT), AND THE USA (BY \$165 MILLION OR 22 PER CENT).

AIRBORNE RE-EXPORTS CONTINUED TO GROW IN 1981. MAJOR RE-EXPORT ITEMS WITH SUBSTANTIAL INCREASES WERE THERMIONIC, COLD CATHODE AND PHOTO-CATHODE VALVES AND TUBES, PHOTOCELLS AND TRANSISTORS (BY \$652 MILLION OR 65 PER CENT), PEARLS, PRECIOUS AND SEMI-PRECIOUS STONES (BY \$509 MILLION OR 46 PER CENT), AND WATCHES AND CLOCKS (BY \$279 MILLION OR 15 PER CENT). ON THE OTHER HAND, AIRBORNE RE-EXPORTS OF SILVER, PLATINUM AND OTHER METALS OF THE PLATINUM GROUP DECLINED SUBSTANTIALLY (BY \$190 MILLION OR 73 PER CENT).

THE USA WAS THE LARGEST MARKET FOR HONG KONG'S AIRBORNE RE-EXPORTS, WITH A VALUE OF \$1 578 MILLION (AN INCREASE OF \$507 MILLION OR 47 PER CENT). INCREASES WERE ALSO REGISTERED IN AIRBORNE RE-EXPORTS TO TAIWAN (BY \$288 MILLION OR 29 PER CENT), SINGAPORE (BY \$254 MILLION OR 26 PER CENT), ISRAEL (BY \$203 MILLION OR 115 PER CENT), PHILIPPINES (BY \$101 MILLION OR 65 PER CENT) AND THE REPUBLIC OF KOREA (BY \$94 MILLION OR 51 PER CENT). AIRBORNE RE-EXPORTS TO SWITZERLAND CONTINUED TO DECLINE (BY \$158 MILLION OR 41 PER CENT).

MICROWAVE MODEL STUDY ON LEI YUE MUN BRIDGE

THE DIRECTOR OF CIVIL AVIATION HAS SIGNED AN AGREEMENT WITH THE UNIVERSITY OF SYDNEY (AUSTRALIA) FOR A MICROWAVE MODEL STUDY INTO THE EFFECT OF THE PROPOSED LEI YUE MUN BRIDGE ON THE ACCURACY OF THE GLIDEPATH OF THE INSTRUMENT LANDING SYSTEM FOR RUNWAY 31 AT HONG KONG INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT.

THE INSTRUMENT LANDING SYSTEM IS A RADIO NAVIGATIONAL AID USED TO GUIDE AIRCRAFT IN LOW CLOUD-BASE AND POOR VISIBILITY CONDITIONS; THE GLIDEPATH IS AN ELEMENT OF THE SYSTEM WHICH DEFINES A SLOPE OF 3 DEGREES FROM THE HORIZONTAL ALONG WHICH THE AIRCRAFT DESCENDS.

THE ACCURACY OF THE GLIDEPATH SIGNAL IS SUSCEPTIBLE TO DEGRADATION BY REFLECTIONS AND RE-RADIATIONS FROM OBSTRUCTIONS SUCH AS A BRIDGE AT LEI YUE MUN, WHICH IF BUILT, WOULD BE A MASSIVE STRUCTURE WITHIN THE RADIATION COVERAGE OF THE GLIDEPATH AERIAL.

+THE OBJECTIVE OF THE MICROWAVE MODEL STUDY IS TO ENSURE THAT THERE WILL BE NO OUT-OF-TOLERANCE ABERRATIONS ON THE GLIDEPATH AND TO MINIMISE THE EFFECT OF THE BRIDGE ON GLIDEPATH ACCURACY BY CHOOSING AN APPROPRIATE BRIDGE DESIGN,+ A SPOKESMAN FOR THE CIVIL AVIATION DEPARTMENT SAID.

+THE UNIVERSITY OF SYDNEY HAS BEEN ASKED TO PRODUCE MODELS AT ABOUT 1/90TH SCALE OF THE GLIDEPATH ANTENNA, THE NEIGHBOURING TERRAIN, BUILDINGS AND THE PROPOSED LEI YUE MUN BRIDGE WITH THE FREQUENCY OF THE GLIDEPATH RADIATION PROPORTIONATELY INCREASED TO SIMULATE THE ELECTROMAGNETIC CHARACTERISTICS OF THE REAL SYSTEM,+ HE ADDED.

MEASUREMENT OF THE GLIDEPATH PERFORMANCE WITH THE PRESENCE OF THE SCALED BRIDGE WILL THEN BE CARRIED OUT ON THE MODELS.

+SEVERAL BRIDGE DESIGNS AND CONSTRUCTION METHODS WILL BE SIMULATED TO DETERMINE WHICH WILL HAVE THE LEAST EFFECT ON THE GLIDEPATH ACCURACY,+ THE SPOKESMAN SAID.

THE STUDY IS EXPECTED TO TAKE ABOUT TEN MONTHS TO COMPLETE.

THE UNIVERSITY OF SYDNEY, WHICH HAS BEEN COMMISSIONED AS A CONSULTANT TO UNDERTAKE THE STUDY, HAS HAD MANY YEARS OF EXPERIENCE IN THE FIELD OF MICROWAVE MODEL STUDY AND HAS A TEST RANGE AVAILABLE FOR USE.

1982 HONG KONG YOUTH MUSIC CAMP

THE MUSIC OFFICE OF THE RECREATION AND CULTURE DEPARTMENT WILL ORGANISE THE 1982 HONG KONG YOUTH MUSIC CAMP FROM JULY 24 TO AUGUST 8 AT ST STEPHEN'S COLLEGE, STANLEY.

THIS FOLLOWS THE SUCCESS OF LAST YEAR'S MUSIC CAMP HELD AT THE YMCA WU KWAI SHA YOUTH VILLAGE.

APART FROM INVITING LOCAL YOUNG MUSICIANS TO JOIN THE CAMP, INVITATIONS WILL ALSO BE EXTENDED TO OVERSEAS YOUNG INSTRUMENTALISTS. IT IS HOPED THAT THROUGH THIS INTENSIVE MUSIC TRAINING IN BOTH WESTERN AND CHINESE INSTRUMENTS IN A SUMMER CAMP ATMOSPHERE, THE MUSICAL CAPABILITIES OF YOUNG PEOPLE WILL BE DEVELOPED AND INTERNATIONAL CULTURAL EXCHANGE BE FOSTERED.

MUSIC TRAINING IN THE FORM OF WORKSHOPS, SEMINARS, MASTER CLASSES, HI-FI MUSIC APPRECIATION, SECTIONAL AND ORCHESTRAL REHEARSALS WILL BE CONDUCTED BY RENOWNED LOCAL AND OVERSEAS MUSICIANS. ASIDE FROM MUSICAL ACTIVITIES, THE YOUNGSTERS WILL ALSO BE ABLE TO ENJOY A FULL RANGE OF CAMP SPORTS ACTIVITIES SUCH AS SWIMMING, TRAMPOLINING, CANOEING, TENNIS, EXCURSIONS, ARCHERY, FOLK DANCE AND BALL GAMES DURING THEIR STAY.

A SPECIAL FINALE CONCERT WILL BE HELD ON AUGUST 7, TO WHICH FAMILIES OF THE YOUNG MUSICIANS WILL BE INVITED TO ATTEND.

THE NEW TERRITORIES SERVICES DEPARTMENT TODAY ADVISED MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC THAT ALL HUMAN REMAINS BURIED IN GRAVES IN NEW TERRITORIES PUBLIC CEMETERIES IN 1975 ARE NOW DUE FOR EXHUMATION.

A NOTICE OF INTENTION TO REMOVE AND DISPOSE OF HUMAN REMAINS FROM CHEUNG CHAU CEMETERY, SANDY RIDGE CEMETERY, SANDY RIDGE URN CEMETERY AND WO HOP SHEK CEMETERY WILL BE PUBLISHED IN THE GOVERNMENT GAZETTE ON FRIDAY (APRIL 2).

THE ANNUAL RE-CYCLE EXERCISE OF RECOVERY OF GRAVE SPACES FROM ALL 1975 COFFIN SECTIONS IN ALL PUBLIC CEMETERIES IN THE NEW TERRITORIES FOR RE-USE PURPOSES IS IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISION OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH AND URBAN SERVICES ORDINANCE, A SPOKESMAN FOR THE NTSD SAID.

A TOTAL OF 9 200 GRAVES -- INCLUDING 7 559 IN WO HOP SHEK CEMETERY AND THE OTHERS IN SANDY RIDGE CEMETERY, SANDY RIDGE URN CEMETERY AND CHEUNG CHAU CEMETERY -- ARE DUE FOR EXHUMATION.

THE EXHUMED REMAINS COULD BE RE-BURIED IN THE URN SECTION OF PUBLIC CEMETERIES OR AFTER CREMATION THE ASHES DEPOSITED IN A NICHE IN A GOVERNMENT OR PRIVATE COLUMBARIUM OR KEPT AT HOME, THE SPOKESMAN SAID.

APPLICATION FOR A PERMISSION TO EXHUME ANY HUMAN REMAINS, WHICH COSTS \$50, SHOULD BE MADE TO THE CEMETERIES AND CREMATORIA OFFICE OF THE NTSD AT 6 CHEONG HANG ROAD, HUNG HOM, BEFORE APRIL 30.

IF THE REMAINS ARE NOT REMOVED OR DISPOSED OF AFTER EXPIRY OF THE ORDER, THEY WILL BE CREMATED AT A GOVERNMENT CREMATORIUM AND THE ASHES RE-BURIED AT THE SANDY RIDGE URN CEMETERY OR OTHER URN CEMETERY.

PROFESSIONAL TRAINING FOR
IN-SERVICE KINDERGARTEN TEACHERS
* * *

PRACTISING KINDERGARTEN TEACHERS WHO ARE NOT PROFESSIONALLY TRAINED CAN NOW APPLY TO ATTEND TWO 12-WEEK COURSES TO BE CONDUCTED IN THE NEXT ACADEMIC YEAR WHICH WILL LEAD TO THE AWARD OF +QUALIFIED ASSISTANT KINDERGARTEN TEACHER+ STATUS.

THESE NEWLY-STRUCTURED COURSES ARE DESIGNED TO PROVIDE KINDERGARTEN TEACHERS WITH THE BASIC TRAINING NECESSARY FOR IMPROVING THE STANDARD OF KINDERGARTEN TEACHING IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE POLICY SET OUT IN THE WHITE PAPER ON PRIMARY EDUCATION AND PRE-PRIMARY SERVICES ISSUED LAST JULY, AN EDUCATION DEPARTMENT SPOKESMAN SAID.

THE FIRST COURSE WILL BE CONDUCTED IN SEPTEMBER THIS YEAR, AND THE SECOND WILL COMMENCE IN MARCH, 1983, HE SAID.

COURSE CONTENTS WILL TAKE INTO CONSIDERATION BOTH THE PRINCIPLES AND PRACTICE OF KINDERGARTEN EDUCATION, AS WELL AS A BASIC UNDERSTANDING OF CHILDREN'S DEVELOPMENT IN THE CONTEXT OF FACTORS INFLUENCING THEIR LEARNING AND BEHAVIOUR WHICH ARE OF SIGNIFICANCE TO CLASSROOM PRACTICE.

EMPHASIS WILL BE PLACED ON THE CONTENT OF THE KINDERGARTEN CURRICULUM AND ITS IMPLEMENTATION, INCLUDING THE GENERAL ORGANISATION OF TIME-TABLES AND ACTIVITIES.

VISITS TO KINDERGARTENS AND OTHER RELATED INSTITUTIONS WILL BE ARRANGED FOR THE TRAINEES.

APPLICANTS SHOULD BE PERMITTED OR REGISTERED KINDERGARTEN TEACHERS OR HEAD TEACHERS CURRENTLY TEACHING FULL-TIME WITH A MINIMUM OF TWO YEARS' TEACHING EXPERIENCE IN A REGISTERED KINDERGARTEN, THE SPOKESMAN SAID.

TRAINEES WILL BE REQUIRED TO ATTEND TWO THREE-HOUR SESSIONS PER WEEK, EITHER FROM 9.30 AM TO 12.30 PM- OR FROM 2 PM TO 5 PM, HE SAID.

THE COURSES WILL BE HELD IN THE ADVISORY INSPECTORATE TEACHING CENTRES, 4 PAK FUK ROAD, SECOND FLOOR, NORTH POINT, HONG KONG.

NO TUITION FEES WILL BE CHARGED AND CLASSES WILL BE CONDUCTED IN CANTONESE.

AN INFORMATION HANDBOOK HAS JUST BEEN PUBLISHED FOR FREE DISTRIBUTION TO +NEW COMERS+ TO TUEN MUN NEW TOWN AS WELL AS OLD TIMERS.

JOINTLY COMPILED BY THE DISTRICT OFFICE AND A YOUTH VOLUNTARY GROUP, THE PUBLICATION CONTAINS USEFUL INFORMATION ON VARIOUS SERVICES SUCH AS MEDICAL, SOCIAL WELFARE, CABLE AND POSTAL, LEGAL AID, RECREATION, EDUCATION, TRANSPORT AND LIBRARY FACILITIES PROVIDED IN THE DISTRICT.

A TOTAL OF 65 000 COPIES HAVE BEEN PRINTED WITH \$60 000 CONTRIBUTED BY THE TUEN MUN DISTRICT BOARD.

THE 28-PAGE HANDBOOK, IN CHINESE ONLY, ALSO CONTAINS A SPECIAL CHAPTER ON THE ORGANISATION OF THE LOCAL DISTRICT BOARD AND RURAL COMMITTEE.
