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MORE STUDIES ON REPLACEMENT AIRPORT PROJECT  
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THE GOVERNMENT HAS ENGAGED CONSULTANTS TO CARRY OUT TWO ENVIRONMENTAL BASELINE STUDIES AS PART OF A SERIES OF STUDIES BEING CONDUCTED IN CONNECTION WITH THE REPLACEMENT AIRPORT PROJECT AT CHEK LAP KOK, OFF NORTHERN LANTAU ISLAND.

AGREEMENTS FOR THESE STUDIES WERE SIGNED TODAY (FRIDAY) BY MR J.T. THORPE, ACTING DIRECTOR OF CIVIL AVIATION, ACTING ON BEHALF OF THE HONG KONG GOVERNMENT, AND OTHER PARTIES CONCERNED.

THE FIRST AGREEMENT, FOR A STUDY OF THE MARINE ENVIRONMENT, IS WITH THE INTERNATIONAL ENVIRONMENTAL CONSULTANTS, ENVIRONMENTAL RESOURCES LTD., REPRESENTED BY DR R. BIDWELL, DEPUTY MANAGING DIRECTOR.

THE SECOND AGREEMENT FOR A STUDY OF THE FLORA AND FAUNA ON CHEK LAP KOK IS WITH PROFESSOR D.A. GRIFFITHS AND PROFESSOR B. LOFTS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF HONG KONG.

ENVIRONMENTAL RESOURCES LTD. WILL BE CARRYING OUT THE STUDY IN ASSOCIATION WITH WATSON HAWKSLEY ASIA OF HONG KONG AND THE DELFT HYDRAULICS LABORATORY OF THE NETHERLANDS.

ENVIRONMENTAL RESOURCES LTD. IS AN INDEPENDENT RESEARCH ORGANISATION SPECIALISING IN ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT AND ALL ASPECTS OF ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT. ITS PREVIOUS WORK IN HONG KONG HAS INCLUDED A STUDY OF CERTAIN OF THE TERRITORY'S ENVIRONMENTAL PROBLEMS. THE SUB-CONTRACTING GROUPS WILL EACH BE RESPONSIBLE FOR SPECIALIST ASPECTS OF THE STUDY.

THE OBJECTIVES OF THIS STUDY ARE TO PREDICT THE LIKELY IMPACTS ON THE MARINE ENVIRONMENT ARISING FROM THE CONSTRUCTION AND OPERATION OF THE PROPOSED REPLACEMENT AIRPORT AND TO IDENTIFY POSSIBLE MEASURES FOR MINIMISING OR AVOIDING SUCH IMPACTS.

THE CONSULTANTS STARTED WORK IMMEDIATELY AFTER THE CONTRACT WAS SIGNED AND WILL COMPLETE THEIR STUDIES TOWARDS THE END OF 1982.

PROFESSOR GRIFFITHS AND PROFESSOR LOFTS WILL BE CARRYING OUT A SHORT SURVEY OF THE FLORA AND FAUNA ON CHEK LAP KOK. THIS SURVEY IS INTENDED TO PROVIDE A RECORD OF THE VEGETATION AND ANIMAL LIFE ON THE ISLAND AND IN PARTICULAR TO IDENTIFY ANY UNIQUE HABITATS OR RARE SPECIES THAT MAY EXIST THERE.

THE RESULTS OF THESE ENVIRONMENTAL STUDIES TOGETHER WITH THE FINDINGS OF THE AIRPORT MASTER PLANNING STUDY AND OTHER STUDIES RELATED TO THE PROPOSED REPLACEMENT AIRPORT AND NORTH LANTAU DEVELOPMENTS WILL BE PRESENTED TO THE GOVERNMENT AT THE END OF NEXT YEAR.

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## COMPENSATION FOR RESUMED NT LAND UNCHANGED

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THE NEW TERRITORIES ADMINISTRATION ANNOUNCED TODAY (FRIDAY) THAT THE PREVAILING COMPENSATION RATES FOR LAND RESUMED IN THE NEW TERRITORIES WOULD REMAIN UNCHANGED.

FROM OCTOBER 1, OWNERS OF AGRICULTURAL LAND RESUMED WITHIN NEW TOWN DEVELOPMENT AREAS WILL STILL BE COMPENSATED AT THE FULL RATE OF \$103 PER SQUARE FOOT.

AT THE SAME TIME, THE EX-GRATIA ALLOWANCE OFFERED TO OWNERS OF RESUMED BUILDING LAND WITHIN NEW TOWN DEVELOPMENT AREAS WILL BE AT THE EXISTING FULL RATE OF \$220 PER SQUARE FOOT.

THE ACTING PRINCIPAL GOVERNMENT LAND AGENT OF THE NTA, MR TONY HARLAND, SAID THE RATES HAD BEEN DRAWN UP IN LINE WITH THE GOVERNMENT'S POLICY OF CONDUCTING HALF-YEARLY REVIEWS OF NEW TERRITORIES COMPENSATION RATES.

THIS POLICY WAS RECOMMENDED BY THE WORKING GROUP ON NEW TERRITORIES URBAN LAND ACQUISITION, WHICH SIR YUET-KEUNG KAN HEADED.

MR HARLAND SAID THE RATES WOULD BE EFFECTIVE UP TO MARCH 31, 1982, WHEN A FURTHER REVIEW WOULD BE CARRIED OUT.

HE POINTED OUT THAT, UNDER THE REVISED GOVERNMENT LAND RESUMPTION POLICY IN THE NEW TERRITORIES, OWNERS OF RESUMED LAND OUTSIDE NEW TOWN DEVELOPMENT AREAS WOULD BE COMPENSATED AT A PROPORTIONATE PERCENTAGE OF THE FULL RATES, DEPENDING ON THE LOCATION OF THE LAND RESUMED, AND MORE PARTICULARLY AS DEFINED IN A ZONAL PLAN AVAILABLE FOR PUBLIC INSPECTION AT THE EIGHT DISTRICT OFFICES OF THE NEW TERRITORIES ADMINISTRATION.

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## NEW 90-CENT DEFINITIVE STAMP OUT IN OCTOBER

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A NEW 90-CENT POSTAGE STAMP IN THE CURRENT DEFINITIVE SERIES WILL BE PLACED ON SALE AT ALL POST OFFICES ON OCTOBER 1, THE POSTMASTER GENERAL ANNOUNCED TODAY.

THE COLOUR OF THE STAMP IS BLACKISH BROWN OR SEPIA.

THERE WILL BE NO FIRST DAY COVER ISSUE ON THIS OCCASION, BUT FOR THE BENEFIT OF PHILATELISTS WHO MAY WANT THEIR COVERS CANCELLED WITH A HAND DATE-STAMP ON THE FIRST DAY OF SALE, SPECIAL POSTING BOXES WILL BE MADE AVAILABLE AT THE GENERAL POST OFFICE, KOWLOON CENTRAL POST OFFICE AND TSIM SHA TSUI POST OFFICE.

ITEMS POSTED IN THESE SPECIAL POSTING BOXES WILL BE CAREFULLY HAND-STAMPED.

A HAND-BACK SERVICE WILL NOT BE PROVIDED ON THIS OCCASION.

THE NEW STAMP WILL BE ON DISPLAY ON THE FIRST FLOOR PUBLIC COUNTER OF THE GENERAL POST OFFICE BUILDING, CONNAUGHT PLACE ON MONDAY (SEPTEMBER 28) FROM 9.30 AM TO 4.30 PM.

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THREE JUSTICES OF APPEAL APPOINTED

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THE QUEEN HAS APPROVED THE APPOINTMENT OF THREE JUDGES OF THE HIGH COURT TO BE JUSTICES OF APPEAL. THEY ARE MR JUSTICE ZIMMERN, MR JUSTICE SILKE AND MR JUSTICE BARKER.

THEIR APPOINTMENT WILL TAKE EFFECT ON MONDAY (SEPTEMBER 28).

MR JUSTICE ZIMMERN WAS BORN IN HONG KONG IN 1917 AND EDUCATED AT THE DIOCESAN BOYS' SCHOOL. HE WAS CALLED TO THE BAR BY THE INNER TEMPLE IN 1958 AND ADMITTED TO THE HONG KONG BAR IN 1959. HE TOOK SILK IN 1973.

HE WAS APPOINTED JUDGE OF THE HIGH COURT IN 1977, MARKING THE FIRST APPOINTMENT FROM THE BAR TO THE HIGH COURT.

MR JUSTICE SILKE WAS BORN IN IRELAND IN 1929. HE WAS EDUCATED AT XAVIER SCHOOL, DUBLIN, AND DUBLIN UNIVERSITY. HE WAS CALLED TO THE BAR IN DUBLIN IN 1955. HE THEN SERVED AS A MAGISTRATE IN NORTH BORNEO AND AS A PUISNE JUDGE OF THE MALAYSIAN JUDICIARY.

HE JOINED THE HONG KONG JUDICIARY AS A MAGISTRATE IN 1969, WAS PROMOTED TO PRESIDENT OF THE TENANCY TRIBUNAL IN 1971 AND WAS MADE PRESIDENT OF THE LANDS TRIBUNAL IN 1974. HE WAS APPOINTED A DISTRICT JUDGE IN 1975 AND JUDGE OF THE HIGH COURT IN 1979.

MR JUSTICE BARKER WAS BORN IN ENGLAND IN 1926. HE WAS EDUCATED AT NOTTINGHAM HIGH SCHOOL AND QUEEN'S COLLEGE, OXFORD. HE WAS CALLED TO THE BAR OF MIDDLE TEMPLE IN 1950 AND BECAME A MEMBER OF THE MIDLAND CIRCUIT.

BETWEEN 1963 AND 1971, HE WAS DEPUTY CHAIRMAN OF THE BUCKINGHAMSHIRE QUARTER SESSION. SINCE 1972 HE HAS BEEN A RECORDER OF THE CROWN COURT. HE TOOK SILK IN 1968 AND BECAME A BENCHER OF HIS INN IN 1975.

HE WAS APPOINTED JUDGE OF THE HIGH COURT IN HONG KONG IN 1979.

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ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION ADVISORY COMMITTEE CHAIRMAN NAMED  
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IT WAS ANNOUNCED TODAY THAT FOLLOWING THE RECENT RE-ORGANISATION OF THE ENVIRONMENT BRANCH, THE ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION ADVISORY COMMITTEE WILL BE CHAIRED BY AN UNOFFICIAL.

THE GOVERNOR HAS APPOINTED MR H.M.G. FORSGATE AS THE CHAIRMAN. MR FORSGATE, WHO HAS A LONG RECORD OF PUBLIC SERVICE AND HAS BEEN VICE-CHAIRMAN OF THE URBAN COUNCIL SINCE APRIL 1, HAS BEEN ASSOCIATED WITH EPCOM AND ITS SPECIAL COMMITTEES SINCE THEY WERE FORMED.

A GOVERNMENT SPOKESMAN SAID THAT IN THE RE-ORGANISATION, IT HAD BEEN DECIDED TO APPOINT AN UNOFFICIAL TO THE CHAIRMANSHIP.

THE POLICY RESPONSIBILITY IN THE GOVERNMENT SECRETARIAT FOR ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION HAS BEEN TRANSFERRED FROM THE SECRETARY FOR THE ENVIRONMENT TO THE DIRECTOR OF ADMINISTRATION AND ENVIRONMENTAL AFFAIRS, MR IAN MACPHERSON. MR MACPHERSON, WHO WAS RECENTLY APPOINTED TO THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL, WILL BE A MEMBER OF EPCOM.

UNDER NEW TERMS OF REFERENCE, EPCOM WILL IN FUTURE ADVISE THE CHIEF SECRETARY THROUGH THE DIRECTOR OF ADMINISTRATION AND ENVIRONMENTAL AFFAIRS ON APPROPRIATE MEASURES TO COMBAT POLLUTION OF ALL KINDS.

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CHA KWO LING OUTLINE ZONING PLAN REVISED

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A REVISED DRAFT OUTLINE ZONING PLAN FOR CHA KWO LING, YAU TONG AND LEI YUE MUN, INCORPORATING ONE AMENDMENT, HAS BEEN PUBLISHED BY THE TOWN PLANNING BOARD.

A SPOKESMAN FOR THE TOWN PLANNING BOARD SAID TODAY (FRIDAY) THAT UNDER THE AMENDMENT, PART OF CHA KWO LING VILLAGE, FORMERLY ZONED FOR COMMERCIAL/RESIDENTIAL, GOVERNMENT, INSTITUTION AND COMMUNITY AND INDUSTRIAL USES, HAD BEEN RE-ZONED TO UNDETERMINED USE.

HE SAID THAT IT WAS THE INTENTION THAT A COMPREHENSIVE DEVELOPMENT STUDY WOULD BE CARRIED OUT TO DETERMINE THE FUTURE USE OF THE WHOLE AREA, INCLUDING THE CHA KWO LING QUARRY, THE KAOLIN MINE AND THE EXISTING CHA KWO LING VILLAGE.

THE AMENDED PLAN IS AVAILABLE FOR INSPECTION UNTIL OCTOBER 15 AT THE TOWN PLANNING OFFICE, 17TH FLOOR, MURRAY BUILDING, GARDEN ROAD- THE CITY DISTRICT OFFICE (CENTRAL AND WESTERN) ENQUIRY SUB-OFFICE, CENTRAL GOVERNMENT OFFICES, WEST WING ENTRANCE, HONG KONG- AND THE CITY DISTRICT OFFICE (KWUN TONG), KWUN TONG DISTRICT BRANCH OFFICES BUILDING, TUNG YAN STREET, THIRD AND FOURTH FLOORS, KOWLOON.

THE DIRECTOR OF AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES, MR JOHN RIDDELL-SWAN, SAID AT THE PRESENTATION OF THE AWARDS TODAY (FRIDAY) THAT NEARLY \$500 000 HAS BEEN PAID OUT IN THE PAST THREE YEARS FOR SCHOLARSHIPS, GRANTS AND LOANS TO STUDENTS TAKING AGRICULTURAL AND FISHERIES SUBJECTS.

+THE MAIN PURPOSE OF THESE AWARDS IS TO INCREASE EXPERTISE IN THE FARMING AND FISHING INDUSTRIES BY ASSISTING DESERVING STUDENTS TO FURTHER THEIR EDUCATION AND TO ENCOURAGE THEM TO RETURN TO HONG KONG TO CONTRIBUTE TO FARMING AND FISHING.

+FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE IS ALSO GIVEN TO STUDENTS, WHOSE PARENTS WORK IN THE AGRICULTURAL AND FISHING INDUSTRIES, TO HELP THEM FURTHER THEIR STUDIES IN OTHER FIELDS,+ HE SAID.

MR RIDDELL-SWAN THANKED ALL MEMBERS OF THE ADVISORY COMMITTEES OF BOTH FUNDS, AND ESPECIALLY THE MEMBERS OF THE SELECTION SUB-COMMITTEE, FOR THEIR ASSISTANCE.
