THE KOWLOON CITY DISTRICT OFFICE HAS ARRANGED A NUMBER OF EVENTS TO PUBLICISE THE DISTRICT BOARD ELECTION TO BE HELD ON SEPTEMBER 23.

ON SATURDAY (SEPTEMBER 18) THE ELECTION CANDIDATES WILL HAVE AN OPPORTUNITY TO EXPLAIN THEIR PLATFORMS AND THE PUBLIC TO ASK THEM QUESTIONS AT THE FOLLOWING MEETINGS:

- A. FOR HO MAN TIN (NORTH) CONSTITUENCY: FROM 2.15 PM TO 4 PM IN PEACE AVENUE PLAYGROUND;
- B. FOR HO MAN TIN (SOUTH) CONSTITUENCY: FROM 7.45 PM TO 10 PM AT THE OI MAN ESTATE COMMUNITY HALL;
- C. FOR HUNG HOM (SOUTH AND NORTH) CONSTITUENCIES: FROM 8 PM TO 9.30 PM AT HOLY CARPENTER COMMUNITY CENTRE, DYER AVENUE; AND
- D. FOR TO KWA WAN (SOUTH) CONSTITUENCY: FROM 3 PM TO 5 PM AT TIN KWONG ROAD GOVERNMENT SECONDARY SCHOOL.

THE NEXT DAY, ON SUNDAY (SEPTEMBER 19), THE CANDIDATES WILL HOLD A PRESS CONFERENCE AT YU KAN HING SECONDARY SCHOOL, STARTING AT 5 PM.

LAST TRAINS FOR LO WU TO BE CANCELLED ON SATURDAY

THE LAST TRAIN LEAVING KOWLOON STATION FOR LO WU AT 11.03 PM WILL BE CANCELLED ON SATURDAY (SEPTEMBER 18) TO FACILITATE ENGINEERING WORK ON A NEW TRACK BETWEEN TAI PO MARKET AND FANLING STATIONS.

A KOWLOON-CANTON RAILWAY SPOKESMAN SAID TODAY (THURSDAY) THAT AS THE WORK FORMS PART OF THE KCR'S FULL ELECTRIFICATION PROGRAMME, SEVERAL FREIGHT TRAINS WILL ALSO BE CANCELLED.

KCR TRAINS WILL START USING THE NEW TRACK BETWEEN TAI PO MARKET AND FANLING FROM 5.45 AM ON SUNDAY (SEPTEMBER 19).

THE SPOKESMAN WARNED THE PUBLIC TO KEEP OFF THE OLD AND NEW TRACKS IN THE AREA AS TRAINS WILL BE RUNNING ON BOTH TRACKS.

WORK STARTS ON NEW RED CROSS CENTRE

THE HONG KONG RED CROSS WILL SOON HAVE A NEW CENTRE AT KING'S PARK RISE, EQUIPPED WITH MODERN FACILITIES FOR THE COLLECTION, PROCESSING, ALLOCATION AND ISSUE OF BLOOD THROUGHOUT THE TERRITORY.

SPEAKING AT THE FOUNDATION-STONE-LAYING CEREMONY OF THE HONG KONG RED CROSS BLOOD TRANSFUSION SERVICE BRADBURY CENTRE, THE DEPUTY DIRECTOR OF MEDICAL AND HEALTH SERVICES, DR S.H. LEE, DESCRIBED THE PROJECT AS +YET ANOTHER EXAMPLE OF JOINT EFFORTS BETWEEN VOLUNTARY ORGANISATIONS AND THE GOVERNMENT IN THE DEVELOPMENT OF MEDICAL AND HEALTH SERVICES FOR THE GOOD OF THE COMMUNITY+.

+WE ARE VERY HAPPY INDEED TO WITNESS THE RESULT OF THESE EFFORTS IN THE FORM OF A BLOOD TRANSFUSION SERVICE CENTRE, WHICH WILL BE THE FIRST OF ITS KIND IN HONG KONG,+ HE SAID.

THE CENTRE WILL FIRST BE BUILT UP TO THREE STOREYS BUT WILL BE SO DESIGNED AS TO ALLOW TWO MORE STOREYS TO BE PUT ON IF REQUIRED.

IT WILL HOUSE A BLOOD TRANSFUSION SERVICE WHICH WILL CENTRALISE ALL ITS ACTIVITIES UNDER ONE ROOF, AND WILL PROVIDE COMPREHENSIVE LABORATORY FACILITIES FOR THE IDENTIFICATION, TESTING, PROCESSING AND PROPER STORAGE OF BLOOD AND BLOOD COMPONENTS.

IT WILL ALSO ALLOCATE AND DISTRIBUTE BLOOD TO ALL HOSPITALS IN HONG KONG.

THIS BUILDING HAS BEEN MADE POSSIBLE THROUGH GENEROUS DONATIONS BY SIR RUN RUN SHAW AND THE BRADBURY CHARITABLE TRUST FUND, WITH THE GOVERNMENT MEETING THE BALANCE OF THE CAPITAL EXPENDITURE AND RECURRENT COSTS.

THE ROAD WILL ALSO BE DESIGNATED AS A 24-HOUR URBAN CLEARWAY FROM 10 AM ON SATURDAY (SEPTEMBER 18).

WEEKDAY CAMPS FOR SPECIAL SCHOOL STUDENTS

STUDENTS OF SPECIAL SCHOOLS WILL BE ABLE TO MAKE USE OF EIGHT CAMPSITES ON WEEKDAYS BETWEEN NOW AND JANUARY 1983 FOR OUTDOOR EDUCATION CAMPS.

THE OBJECTIVES OF THESE CAMPS ARE TO PROVIDE SPECIAL SCHOOL STUDENTS WITH EXPERIENCE OF LIVING IN A NATURAL OUTDOOR ENVIRONMENT, AND TO PROVIDE OPPORTUNITIES FOR INTEGRATION OF SCHOOL SUBJECTS UNDER CAMPING SITUATIONS, AN EDUCATION DEPARTMENT SPOKESMAN SAID.

THE CAMPSITES ARE GAUDETE HOUSE, WU KWAI SHA, SILVERMINE BAY, Y.W.C.A. CAMP, PAK TAM CHUNG, MA WAN, SUEN DOUH AND PHAB CENTRE.

APPLICATIONS SHOULD BE MADE TO THE PHYSICAL EDUCATION SECTION OF THE ADVISORY INSPECTORATE, EDUCATION DEPARTMENT AT KOWLOON GOVERNMENT OFFICES, 6/F, 405 NATHAN ROAD.

THE SPOKESMAN SAID THAT NO FEES WILL BE CHARGED AS THE CAMPS ARE FULLY FINANCED BY THE HO TUNG CHARITABLE FUND.

THE MAXIMUM NUMBER OF PARTICIPANTS FOR EACH SCHOOL IS 40.

ALL CAMPS ARE OF THREE DAYS' DURATION, LASTING EITHER FROM MONDAY TO WEDNESDAY OR FROM WEDNESDAY TO FRIDAY.

ADAPTED SCHOOL LESSONS WILL BE CONDUCTED IN THE MORNING BY THE ACCOMPANYING TEACHERS, WITH EXCURSIONS, EDUCATIONAL VISITS, BALL GAMES AND SWIMMING IN THE AFTERNOON.

FOLK DANCING, RECREATIONAL GAMES, CAMP FIRES AND FILM SHOWS WILL BE ORGANISED IN THE EVENING.

+NO STUDENTS WILL BE ALLOWED TO ATTEND ANY CAMP WITHOUT PRIOR WRITTEN PERMISSION FROM THEIR PARENTS,+ THE SPOKESMAN SAID.

BUNKS, BLANKETS, BED SHEETS AND PILLOWS WILL BE PROVIDED AT THE CAMPS.
