SNT TOURS LANTAU AND PENG CHAU  
\* \* \*

THE SECRETARY FOR THE NEW TERRITORIES, MR DAVID AKERS-JONES, SPENT THE WHOLE OF TODAY (THURSDAY) MEETING LEADERS OF A DOZEN TOWNS AND VILLAGES ON LANTAU AND PENG CHAU ISLANDS.

MR AKERS-JONES AND THE LEADERS DISCUSSED A RANGE OF SUBJECTS INCLUDING DEVELOPMENT PROJECTS, THE LIVING ENVIRONMENT AND ROAD IMPROVEMENT WORKS.

ACCOMPANIED BY ISLANDS DISTRICT OFFICER, MR NICKY LO, MR AKERS-JONES FIRST FLEW TO TAI O BY HELICOPTER WHERE HE WAS GREETED BY THE RURAL COMMITTEE CHAIRMAN, MR YU YUEN-HEI.

THEY TOURED LUNG TIN ESTATE, A MAJOR VILLAGE-TYPE PUBLIC HOUSING ESTATE, THE FIRST STAGE OF WHICH WAS COMPLETED EARLY THIS YEAR.

ESTATE RESIDENTS ARE MOSTLY FORMER SQUATTERS FROM NEARBY AREAS. WHEN FULLY OCCUPIED, THE FIRST STAGE OF THE ESTATE WILL PROVIDE HOMES FOR 1 300 PEOPLE.

MR AKERS-JONES THEN TOURED SHEK TSAI PO VILLAGE BEFORE GOING ON TO TUNG CHUNG WHERE HE WAS MET BY THE RURAL COMMITTEE CHAIRMAN, MR CHONG CHU-CHOI, AND SHOWN THE HAU WONG TEMPLE SPORTSGROUND AT PRESENT BEING CONSTRUCTED. HE ALSO SAW THE INTENDED SITES FOR A LOCAL RURAL COMMITTEE OFFICE.

MR AKERS-JONES THEN WENT TO SOUTH LANTAU, VISITING SHUI HAU, TONG FUK AND PUI O, ACCOMPANIED BY THE CHAIRMAN OF THE SOUTH LANTAU RURAL COMMITTEE, MR LAU YUNG-FUK.

IN THE AFTERNOON, MR AKERS-JONES VISITED CHUNG HAU, LUK TEI TONG, TAI TEI TONG AND PAK NGAN HEUNG, BEFORE GOING BY LAUNCH TO PENG CHAU ISLAND. HE MET THE ISLAND'S RURAL COMMITTEE CHAIRMAN, MR WONG CHING.

HE RETURNED TO HONG KONG IN THE LATE AFTERNOON.

SALVATION ARMY LEADER PRAISES PRISONS DEPT

THE VISITING INTERNATIONAL LEADER OF THE SALVATION ARMY, GENERAL ARNOLD BROWN, TODAY (THURSDAY) VISITED CHI MA WAN AND PRAISED THE PRISONS DEPARTMENT FOR ITS EFFICIENT MANAGEMENT OF THE CAMP WHERE MORE THAN 3 100 ILLEGAL VIETNAMESE IMMIGRANTS ARE BEING ACCOMMODATED.

HE SAID HE HAD BEEN TO MANY SIMILAR CAMPS IN OTHER PARTS OF THE WORLD AND THIS WAS ONE OF THE BEST HE HAD SEEN.

GEN BROWN WAS ACCOMPANIED ON THE VISIT BY THE COMMISSIONER OF PRISONS, MR T.G. GARNER, SENIOR PRISON STAFF AND SENIOR SALVATION ARMY OFFICERS.

GEN BROWN TOURED THE CAMP AND WATCHED VARIOUS RECREATIONAL ACTIVITIES AND EDUCATIONAL CLASSES ORGANISED BY LOCAL SALVATION ARMY PERSONNEL.

PREVOCATIONAL SCHOOLS TO JOIN HKCEE IN 1983  
\* \* \* \* \*

PREVOCATIONAL SCHOOLS WILL BEGIN TO OPERATE SENIOR SECONDARY FORMS IN 1981 AND WILL JOIN THE HONG KONG CERTIFICATE OF EDUCATION EXAMINATION FOR THE FIRST TIME IN 1983, MR T.L. LAM, ASSISTANT DIRECTOR OF EDUCATION (SCHOOLS), SAID TODAY (THURSDAY).

+TECHNICAL AND SPECIAL SUBJECTS OFFERED BY THESE SCHOOLS, SUCH AS ENGINEERING SCIENCE, TEXTILES, FOOD AND RELATED HOTEL SERVICES, ARE EXPECTED TO BE MADE EXAMINABLE BY STAGES IN THE HKCEE, + HE SAID.

MR LAM WAS SPEAKING AT A SEMINAR ON +THE CHALLENGES OF PREVOCATIONAL EDUCATION IN THE 80'S+ JOINTLY ORGANISED BY THE HONG KONG PREVOCATIONAL SCHOOLS COUNCIL AND THE EDUCATION COMMITTEE OF THE COUNCIL OF SOCIAL SERVICE.

HE NOTED THAT IN PREPARATION FOR THE HKCEE, PERMISSION WAS GRANTED FOR ALL PREVOCATIONAL SCHOOLS TO EMPLOY GRADUATE MASTERS IN THE CURRENT SCHOOL YEAR TO IMPROVE THE STANDARD OF TEACHING.

IN THE CURRENT ACADEMIC YEAR THERE ARE SOME 10 000 STUDENTS STUDYING IN THE 13 PREVOCATIONAL SCHOOLS.

ANOTHER 12 NEW SCHOOLS ARE EXPECTED TO BE BUILT STARTING IN 1982, AND IT IS EXPECTED THAT ON THEIR COMPLETION IN 1984 THE NUMBER OF STUDENTS WILL RISE TO 22 500.

+THERE WERE OVER 12 000 APPLICATIONS FROM PRIMARY 6 STUDENTS COMPETING FOR THE 3 000 FORM 1 PLACES AVAILABLE IN PREVOCATIONAL SCHOOLS IN THIS SCHOOL YEAR, WHICH MEANS EVERY FROM 1 SEAT WAS OVERSUBSCRIBED BY FOUR TIMES.

+THIS SHOWS THAT PREVOCATIONAL EDUCATION IS POPULAR AMONG THE PUBLIC, PARENTS AND STUDENTS,+ MR LAM SAID.

### HIKING SCHEME TO START NEXT MONTH

\* \* \*

THE GOVERNMENT'S RECREATION AND SPORT SERVICE IS ORGANISING A 14-MONTH HIKING SCHEME STARTING NEXT MONTH (NOVEMBER).

THE +CHONG HING HIKING SCHEME+ IS BEING ORGANISED BY THE RSS AND SPONSORED BY LIU CHONG HING BANK. IT WILL BE HELD EVERY SUNDAY STARTING NEXT MONTH UNTIL DECEMBER 1981.

THERE ARE 16 ROUTES WINDING THROUGH THE MOST SCENIC AREAS IN THE EASTERN PART OF THE NEW TERRITORIES. JOURNEY TIMES RANGE FROM THREE TO SIX HOURS.

THE ROUTES ARE DIVIDED INTO FOUR GROUPS, WITH FOUR GRADINGS OF DIFFICULTIES. PARTICIPANTS WILL BE LED BY EXPERIENCED TEAM LEADERS WHO WILL ALSO INTRODUCE TO THE HIKERS THE SCENIC SPOTS ALONG THE ROUTES.

RECREATION AND SPORT OFFICER, MR P.H. TAM, SAID THE HIKING SCHEME WAS TO ENCOURAGE THE PUBLIC TO TAKE PART IN REGULAR HIKING TO PROMOTE THE CONCEPT OF +WALK FOR YOUR HEALTH.+

HE POINTED OUT THAT THE SPECIAL FEATURE OF THIS SCHEME WAS TO IMPLEMENT A +MEMBERSHIP SCHEME+ TO ENABLE MEMBERS IN A HIKING GROUP TO PLAN OUTINGS TOGETHER WELL IN ADVANCE.

THE SCHEME IS A NEW VENTURE AND MR TAM EXPECTED ABOUT 5 000 PEOPLE WOULD BE REGISTERED AS +MEMBERS+ AND THAT THE WHOLE SCHEME WOULD ATTRACT 40 000 PARTICIPANTS.

TO PROMOTE INTEREST, THOSE WHO COMPLETE A CERTAIN NUMBER OF ROUTES WILL BE PRESENTED WITH A MEDAL. THOSE WITH AN OUTSTANDING RECORD WILL BE INVITED TO TAKE PART IN A SPECIAL OUTING TO BE HELD AT THE CLOSING CEREMONY OF THE SCHEME. ON COMPLETION OF THE WALK THEY WILL RECEIVE A SPECIAL AWARD.

THE OPENING CEREMONY FOR THE SCHEME HAS BEEN SCHEDULED FOR 10 AM ON OCTOBER 26 (SUNDAY) AT THE WAN CHAI GAP PARK.

ENTRY FORMS FOR THE HIKING SCHEME ARE NOW AVAILABLE AT ALL OFFICES OF THE RSS. COMPLETED ENTRY FORMS SHOULD BE RETURNED, TOGETHER WITH TWO PHOTOGRAPHS AND AN ENTRY FEE OF \$10, TO THE RECREATION AND SPORT SERVICE, 111 CONNAUGHT ROAD CENTRAL, WING ON CENTRE, 11TH FLOOR.

### TAI PO TO FORM DISTRICT CHILDREN'S CHOIR

\* \* \*

A DRIVE IS BEING LAUNCHED IN TAI PO TO RECRUIT 100 CHILDREN WITH A FLAIR FOR SINGING TO FORM A CHILDREN'S CHOIR.

THE BOYS AND GIRLS CHOSEN WOULD BE THE DISTRICT'S +MUSIC AMBASSADORS,+ A DISTRICT OFFICE SPOKESMAN SAID TODAY (THURSDAY).

THEY WOULD BE REPRESENTING TAI PO IN CULTURAL ACTIVITIES OUTSIDE THE DISTRICT AND WOULD ALSO BE PLAYING AN IMPORTANT ROLE IN PROMOTING MUSIC AMONG LOCAL RESIDENTS.

ALL TAI PO CHILDREN AGED FROM EIGHT TO 14 ARE ELIGIBLE TO APPLY BUT THEY WILL FIRST HAVE TO PASS A VOCAL TEST.

THE SPOKESMAN URGED PARENTS AND TEACHERS TO ENCOURAGE THEIR CHILDREN AND STUDENTS TO JOIN THE CHOIR.

+IT WILL BE A MEANINGFUL EXTRA-CURRICULAR ACTIVITY WHICH WILL DEVELOP THEIR MUSICAL POTENTIAL,+ HE SAID.

BESIDES SINGING, THERE WILL BE TRAINING IN INSTRUMENT PLAYING AND MUSIC APPRECIATION. OUTINGS AND VISITS WILL ALSO BE ORGANISED TO MAINTAIN INTEREST.

HE ASSURED THAT JOINING THE CHOIR WOULD NOT AFFECT SCHOOL WORK AS PRACTICE WOULD BE HELD ON SUNDAY AFTERNOONS AT A LOCAL SCHOOL AND ACTIVITIES WOULD BE HELD MAINLY AT WEEKENDS AND ON HOLIDAYS.

THE CHOIR IS BEING ORGANISED BY THE DISTRICT'S NEWLY-FORMED ARTS ADVANCEMENT ASSOCIATION WITH FUNDS PROVIDED BY THE DISTRICT ADVISORY BOARD. THE MUSIC OFFICE WILL HELP WITH TRAINING.

IT IS PLANNED THAT THE CHOIR WILL GIVE ITS FIRST CONCERT IN SIX TO EIGHT MONTHS.

APPLICATION FORMS ARE BEING SENT TO ALL SCHOOLS IN THE DISTRICT. THEY ARE ALSO AVAILABLE FROM THE DISTRICT OFFICE, TAI KWONG SECONDARY SCHOOL AND THE LION'S CLUB TAI PO YOUTH CENTRE.

TEMPORARY WAN CHAI TRAFFIC ARRANGEMENTS

TEMPORARY TRAFFIC ARRANGEMENTS WILL BE IMPLEMENTED IN WAN CHAI TO FACILITATE ROAD REPAIR WORKS IN THE CROSS HARBOUR TUNNEL AREA.

THE EXIT ROAD LINKING THE TUNNEL WITH HAPPY VALLEY WILL BE CLOSED TO ALL TRAFFIC FROM 9.30 PM TO 6 AM THE FOLLOWING DAY ON OCTOBER 12, 13, 14 AND 29. MOTORISTS CAN USE THE NORTH POINT EXIT ROAD ON THE WATERFRONT SECTION OF GLOUCESTER ROAD EASTBOUND AS AN ALTERNATIVE.

CROSS HARBOUR TUNNEL BUS ROUTE NOS. 101, 111, 112, 113, 116, 121 AND 122 FROM KOWLOON WHEN LEAVING THE TUNNEL WOULD BE DIVERTED VIA NORTH POINT EXIT ROAD, GLOUCESTER ROAD EASTBOUND, VICTORIA PARK FLYOVER, GLOUCESTER ROAD WESTBOUND, CANAL ROAD FLYOVER AND THEN REVERT TO THE NORMAL ROUTES.

THE APPROACH ROAD LEADING FROM HAPPY VALLEY AND CANAL ROAD TO THE CROSS HARBOUR TUNNEL WILL BE CLOSED TO ALL TRAFFIC FROM 9.30 PM TO 6 AM THE FOLLOWING DAY ON OCTOBER 20, 21, 22, 23 AND 28.

MOTORISTS WISHING TO GO TO THE CROSS HARBOUR TUNNEL CAN USE THE APPROACH ROAD ON THE WATERFRONT SECTION OF GLOUCESTER ROAD EASTBOUND AS AN ALTERNATIVE.

CROSS HARBOUR TUNNEL BUS ROUTE NOS. 101, 111, 112, 113, 116, 121, 122 AND 170 LEAVING HONG KONG FOR KOWLOON FROM THE CANAL ROAD FLYOVER WOULD BE DIVERTED VIA THE DOWN RAMP OF CANAL ROAD FLYOVER TO CAUSEWAY BAY, GLOUCESTER ROAD EASTBOUND, VICTORIA PARK FLYOVER, GLOUCESTER ROAD WESTBOUND, THE UP RAMP OF THE WATERFRONT APPROACH ROAD TO THE TUNNEL AND THEN REVERT TO THEIR NORMAL ROUTES ON ENTERING THE TUNNEL.

THE NORTH POINT EXIT ROAD LEADING FROM THE CROSS HARBOUR TUNNEL TO THE WATERFRONT SECTION OF GLOUCESTER ROAD EASTBOUND WILL BE CLOSED TO TRAFFIC BETWEEN 9.30 PM AND 6 AM THE FOLLOWING DAY ON OCTOBER 30.
