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## GOVERNOR OPENS ABERDEEN SWIMMING POOL

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HONG KONG'S LATEST, MOST SCENIC AND BEST EQUIPPED SWIMMING POOL COMPLEX, AT ABERDEEN, WAS OPENED TODAY BY THE GOVERNOR, SIR MURRAY MACLEHOSE, WHO PAID TRIBUTE TO THE MAN WHOSE DONATION OF \$10 MILLION LARGELY FUNDED THE COMPLEX, MR. Y.K. PAO.

THE NINE-POOL COMPLEX, BUILT FOR THE URBAN COUNCIL BY THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT AT A TOTAL COST OF ABOUT \$12 MILLION, OCCUPIES AN IMPRESSIVE SITE BELOW THE DENSELY POPULATED WONG CHUK HANG HOUSING ESTATE AND LOOKS OUT OVER THE BOAT HARBOUR AT SHUM WAN BAY. THE LAND, VALUED AT AN ESTIMATED \$140 MILLION, WAS DONATED BY THE GOVERNMENT.

ITS FEATURES INCLUDE NEW FACILITIES FOR THE HANDICAPPED, WITH CHANGING-ROOMS DESIGNED SPECIALLY FOR THEM AND WITH A RAMP TO ENABLE WHEELCHAIRS TO MOVE EASILY FROM THE TEACHING-POOL LEVEL UP TO THE MAIN 50-METRE OLYMPIC-SIZE POOL.

IN ADDITION TO THE MAIN POOL, WHICH CAN BE HEATED IN WINTER, THERE ARE: A SECONDARY POOL OF THE SAME SIZE= A DIVING POOL= TWO TEACHING POOLS= A TRAINING POOL= AND THREE PADDLING POOLS FOR CHILDREN.

CONSTRUCTION WORK ON THE COMPLEX STARTED IN AUGUST 1975. EVEN BEFORE THE OFFICIAL OPENING TODAY, ITS FACILITIES HAVE BEEN ENJOYED BY THOUSANDS OF ABERDEEN RESIDENTS SINCE IT WAS OPENED TO THE PUBLIC TWO WEEKS AGO.

AFTER UNVEILING A PLAGUE AT THE ENTRANCE TO THE COMPLEX, SIR MURRAY, SPEAKING AT THE SIDE OF THE MAIN POOL, SAID THAT ABERDEEN WAS LUCKY TO HAVE THIS FINE NEW FACILITY, WHICH WOULD BRING A WELCOME ADDITIONAL SOURCE OF ENJOYMENT FOR THE PEOPLE OF THIS RAPIDLY DEVELOPING PART OF HONG KONG ISLAND.

HE EXPRESSED WARM PRAISE FOR THE GENEROSITY OF MR. Y.K. PAO AND SAID HE WAS CONFIDENT THAT THE COMPLEX WOULD BE WELL AND EFFICIENTLY MANAGED BY THE URBAN SERVICES DEPARTMENT ON BEHALF OF THE URBAN COUNCIL.

HE ALSO WELCOMED THE PRESENCE AT THE CEREMONY OF SIR PAUL BRYAN, M.P., CHAIRMAN OF THE ANGLO-HONG KONG PARLIAMENTARY GROUP, AND LADY BRYAN, WHO ARE VISITING HONG KONG.

THE CHAIRMAN OF THE URBAN COUNCIL, MR. A. DE O. SALES, WHO INVITED THE GOVERNOR TO OPEN THE COMPLEX, SAID HE WAS PARTICULARLY HAPPY THAT THE COMPLEX, THE EIGHTH TO BE COMPLETED IN THE URBAN AREAS OF HONG KONG AND KOWLOON, EMBODIES EXTRA FACILITIES TO SERVE THE HANDICAPPED.

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HE ALSO NOTED THAT THIS WAS THE FIRST COMPLEX WHOSE MAIN POOL CAN BE HEATED IN WINTER.

MR. Y.K. PAO, SPEAKING AFTER THE GOVERNOR, SAID THAT IT WAS A CREDIT TO THE GOVERNMENT THAT IN RECENT YEARS GREAT EFFORTS HAD BEEN MADE TO SEE THAT REQUIREMENTS FOR EXERCISE FACILITIES ARE INCREASINGLY MET.

+THE URBAN COUNCIL, WHO HAVE BEEN CHARGED WITH THIS TASK, ARE TO BE CONGRATULATED FOR HAVING CHOSEN ABERDEEN AS THE LOCATION TO BUILD THIS LARGE MULTI-PURPOSE SWIMMING POOL COMPLEX FOR THE DIRECT BENEFIT OF THE EVER-GROWING POPULATION IN THE IMMEDIATE AND ADJACENT AREAS.

+TODAY, AS THE POOL IS OFFICIALLY OPENED, I PERSONALLY FEEL EXTREMELY HAPPY TO HAVE PLAYED A PART IN SEEING THIS PROJECT COME TO FRUITION.+

MR. PAO, WHO DESCRIBED HIMSELF AS AN ENTHUSIASTIC DAILY SWIMMER, SAID THAT THE IDEA OF HIS DONATION ORIGINATED WHEN HE AND THE GOVERNOR WERE BOTH PRESENT AT A CEREMONY AT PLYMOUTH, ENGLAND, IN 1971.

+HIS EXCELLENCY SEEMED TO BE IMPRESSED BY A CASUAL MENTION OF MY GREAT INTEREST IN SWIMMING AND THE SUGGESTION WAS MADE THEN THAT PERHAPS I WOULD CARE TO HELP WITH THE COST OF CONSTRUCTION OF A SWIMMING POOL IN HONG KONG TO FURTHER PROMOTE THE SPORT AMONG OUR HARD-WORKING PEOPLE.

+IMAGINE MY SATISFACTION AND HAPPINESS TODAY TO SEE A SIX-YEAR-OLD PROPOSITION COME TO REALITY.+

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HAYE SPEAKS OUT AGAINST SMEAR CAMPAIGNS ON EDUCATIONAL ACHIEVEMENTS  
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THE DEPUTY DIRECTOR OF EDUCATION (ADMINISTRATION), MR. COLVYN HAYE, TODAY SPOKE OUT AGAINST SMEAR CAMPAIGNS WHICH DISCOUNTED ACHIEVEMENTS IN EDUCATION.

HE WAS ADDRESSING THE GATHERING AT THE GOLDEN JUBILEE JOINT PRIZE-GIVING CEREMONY OF ST. CLARE'S GIRLS' SCHOOL, ST. CLARE'S PRIMARY SCHOOL AND SHEK PAI WAN ST. PETER'S EVENING SCHOOL IN THE COMMUNITY HALL OF CARITAS HOUSE.

MR. HAYE SAID : +IT HAS RECENTLY BECOME FASHIONABLE TO SNEER AT THE CONCRETE ACHIEVEMENTS OF RELIGIOUS AND OTHER SPONSORS OF EDUCATION.

+SMEAR CAMPAIGNS ARE LAUNCHED BY THE MALICIOUS TO DISCOUNT POSITIVE ACHIEVEMENTS IN EDUCATION OVER THE LAST FIFTY YEARS. UNFORTUNATELY THERE WILL ALWAYS BE A MARKET FOR THE GULLIBLE. IT IS EASY TO CRITICISE, MUCH LESS EASY TO BE CHARITABLE.+

THE DEPUTY DIRECTOR TOOK THE OPPORTUNITY TO STATE PUBLICLY THAT +TRUTH WILL CONQUER AND THAT MALICIOUS RUMOUR-MONGERS WILL BE EXPOSED.+

HE ADVISED THE AUDIENCE NOT TO LISTEN TO MALICIOUS RUMOURS AND NOT TO SUBSCRIBE TO THEM.

MR. HAYE ADDED : +WHEN ALLEGATIONS ARE MADE, YOU MAY BE SURE THAT THE AUTHORITIES CONCERNED ALWAYS TAKE PROMPT ACTION TO INVESTIGATE. IT IS NOT ALWAYS POSSIBLE TO COMMENT PUBLICLY ON THE RESULT OF INVESTIGATIONS UNTIL THEY HAVE BEEN COMPLETED, AND, IF WARRANTED, THE DUE PROCESSES OF THE LAW HAVE TAKEN THEIR PROPER COURSE.

+BUT WHAT OF OTHER PROPER PROCESSES? AND HERE I AM TALKING ABOUT FAIR-MINDEDNESS, CHARITY, TRUTH AND DECENCY. SURELY THESE HAVE A PLACE IN ANY CIVILISED SOCIETY.+

HE SAID THAT THE MANY ACHIEVEMENTS OF ST. CLARE'S GIRLS' SCHOOL, ST. CLARE'S PRIMARY SCHOOL AND SHEK PAI WAN ST. PETER'S EVENING SCHOOL WERE A MATTER OF PUBLIC RECORD.

THE SCHOOLS' ANNUAL REPORT URGED THE GRADUATES OF 1977 TO RECALL THE DAYS SPENT IN THE SCHOOLS AS YEARS OF GRACE WHERE THEY COULD GATHER NOT ONLY KNOWLEDGE BUT CHARACTER FORMATION.

+YOU ARE ASKED TO USE THESE WELL IN THE YEARS TO COME AND SHARE WITH LESS FORTUNATE ONES, ALWAYS LIVING UP TO THE MOTTO 'TRUTH CONQUERS'.+

THE DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAID TRIBUTE TO THE MISSIONARY SISTERS OF OUR LADY OF THE ANGELS FOR HAVING DONE SO MUCH FOR EDUCATION IN HONG KONG OVER THE LAST 50 YEARS.

HE ASSURED THE SISTERS THAT THE EDUCATION DEPARTMENT APPRECIATED ALL THAT THEY HAD DONE AND WOULD CONTINUE TO DO.

DURING THE CEREMONY MRS. HAYE DISTRIBUTED CERTIFICATES AND PRIZES.

RISING ENROLMENTS IN PREVOCATIONAL SCHOOLS

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THERE ARE MORE THAN 5,700 PUPILS IN EIGHT PREVOCATIONAL SCHOOLS AT PRESENT. IN SEPTEMBER THE ENROLMENT WILL BE NEARLY 6,200 IN TEN SUCH SCHOOLS.

IN SEPTEMBER 1980 THERE WILL BE 13 PREVOCATIONAL SCHOOLS WITH SOME 9,500 PUPILS. AND THE ENROLMENT BY SEPTEMBER 1982 IS EXPECTED TO RISE TO MORE THAN 10,800 IN THESE 13 SCHOOLS.

THESE STATISTICS WERE QUOTED BY THE DIRECTOR OF EDUCATION, MR. KENNETH TOPLEY WHEN HE ADDRESSED PUPILS AND GUESTS AT THE PRIZE-GIVING CEREMONY OF THE HOLY CARPENTER PREVOCATIONAL SCHOOL THIS AFTERNOON. THE CEREMONY WAS HELD AT THE MORRISON HILL TECHNICAL INSTITUTE.

+THE NUMBER OF APPLICANTS SEEKING ENTRY INTO PREVOCATIONAL SCHOOLS IN THE NEXT ACADEMIC YEAR IS FIVE TIMES MORE THAN THE NUMBER OF PLACES AVAILABLE. THIS SHOWS THAT PREVOCATIONAL SCHOOLS, WHICH ARE FULLY AIDED BY THE GOVERNMENT, ARE HERE TO STAY AND THEIR CONTINUED POPULARITY IS A CLEAR INDICATION THAT THEY ARE FULFILLING A NEED,+ MR. TOPLEY SAID.

THE DIRECTOR TOOK THE OPPORTUNITY TO REASSURE SPONSORS OF PREVOCATIONAL SCHOOLS THAT THEIR SCHOOLS HAD AN INTEGRAL PART TO PLAY IN THE EDUCATION SYSTEM.

+ALTHOUGH PREVOCATIONAL EDUCATION IS A SMALL PART IN THE SYSTEM IT IS NEVERTHELESS AN IMPORTANT ELEMENT IN THE EDUCATION PLAN.

+I HOPE THIS STATEMENT WILL REMOVE ANY DOUBTS ABOUT THE ROLE OF PREVOCATIONAL SCHOOLS WHICH, INCIDENTALY, ARE NOT IN EXISTENCE TO PROVIDE A FORM OF VOCATIONAL EDUCATION. THESE SCHOOLS DO NOT TURN OUT 'INSTANT CRAFTSMEN'. THEY ARE PART AND PARCEL OF OUR SECONDARY SCHOOL SYSTEM.

+BECAUSE OF THIS, I HAVE TRANSFERRED RESPONSIBILITY FOR PREVOCATIONAL SCHOOLS FROM THE TECHNICAL DIVISION TO THE SECONDARY DIVISION. IN THIS WAY, ALL SECONDARY SCHOOLS ARE HANDLED BY THE SAME DIVISION IN MY DEPARTMENT. THE TECHNICAL DIVISION WILL CONTINUE TO BE CONSULTED WHEN THE SECONDARY DIVISION REQUIRES ADVICE ON THE TECHNICAL ASPECTS,+ MR. TOPLEY SAID.

DURING THE PAST SEVEN OR EIGHT YEARS,HONG KONG'S INDUSTRY HAS BECOME MORE DIVERSIFIED AND SOPHISTICATED REQUIRING BETTER EDUCATED AND MORE ADAPTABLE EMPLOYEES WITH A WIDER EDUCATIONAL BASE.

+WE ALSO KNOW THAT NINE YEARS OF GENERAL EDUCATION WILL BE AVAILABLE FOR ALL,+ THE DIRECTOR SAID.

HE ADDED : +BECAUSE OF SUCH CHANGES AND BECAUSE CURRICULUM DEVELOPMENT MUST BE AN ONGOING PROCESS WE ARE LOOKING AT THE CURRICULUM AND SYLLABUSES IN ALL OUR PREVOCATIONAL SCHOOLS. (THE PREVOCATIONALS THEMSELVES ARE INVOLVED IN THIS EXERCISE). I AM SURE YOU WILL AGREE WE MUST GET THEM RIGHT AND MAKE SURE THEY ARE PROVIDING WHAT IS REQUIRED.+

/WHILE THE .....

WHILE THE TECHNICAL PART OF THE CURRICULUM WOULD REMAIN BETWEEN 40 AND 50 PER CENT, IT WAS VERY IMPORTANT THAT PREVOCATIONAL SCHOOLS DID NOT TRY TO BECOME MINIATURE TECHNICAL INSTITUTES.

+THE WORKSHOPS, MACHINERY AND WORK DONE MUST BE RELATED TO THE SIZE AND AGE OF THE PUPILS. SAFETY TOO IS OBVIOUSLY OF VITAL IMPORTANCE,+ MR. TOPLEY STRESSED.

HE CONTINUED : +SYLLABUSES IN PREVOCATIONAL SCHOOLS HAVE ALWAYS MARRIED UP TO SYLLABUSES IN TECHNICAL INSTITUTES. THIS IS IMPORTANT BECAUSE PREVOCATIONAL SCHOOL LEAVERS WHO HAVE STUDIED A CRAFT IN DEPTH ENTER DIRECTLY INTO THE SECOND YEAR OF AN APPRENTICESHIP AND THE SECOND YEAR OF A PART-TIME DAY-RELEASE COURSE.+

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RESULTS OF TENDER FOR 300 URBAN TAXI LICENCES  
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THE TRANSPORT DEPARTMENT HAS COMPLETED PROCESSING THE TENDERS FOR 300 HONG KONG AND KOWLOON TAXI LICENCES.

A TOTAL OF 6,798 INDIVIDUAL TENDERS HAD BEEN RECEIVED WHEN THE OFFER CLOSED ON JUNE 17, 1977. THE HIGHEST TENDER WAS \$196,005, AND THE LOWEST \$10,000.

A TRANSPORT DEPARTMENT SPOKESMAN SAID TODAY (FRIDAY) THAT 283 OF THE 300 URBAN TAXI LICENCES WILL BE ALLOCATED TO TENDERERS OFFERING A UNIT PREMIUM OF OVER \$181,000.

THE REMAINING 17 URBAN TAXI LICENCES WILL BE DETERMINED BY PUBLIC BALLOT TO BE HELD ON THURSDAY (JULY 14) AT 2.30 P.M. ON THE FIFTH FLOOR OF THE HUNG HOM MULTI-STOREY CAR PARK.

THE SPOKESMAN SAID THAT THERE WERE 11 TENDERS EACH OFFERING THE SAME UNIT PREMIUM OF \$181,000 FOR A TOTAL OF 50 TAXI LICENCES.

+THE PUBLIC BALLOT IS TO DETERMINE WHICH OF THE 11 TENDERERS WILL GET THE REMAINING 17 URBAN TAXI LICENCES,+ HE SAID.

THE SPOKESMAN ADDED THAT TENDERERS WHO OFFERED A UNIT PREMIUM OF UNDER \$181,000 WERE UNSUCCESSFUL BUT THAT THEY COULD TRY AGAIN WHEN URBAN TAXI LICENCES WERE NEXT OFFERED BY THE TRANSPORT DEPARTMENT.

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## WARNING AGAINST ILLEGAL DISMISSAL OF WORKERS

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EMPLOYERS MUST NOT DISMISS WORKERS DURING THEIR PERIOD OF SICK LEAVE AS A RESULT OF AN INJURY SUSTAINED AT WORK, ASSISTANT COMMISSIONER FOR LABOUR, MR. DAVID LIN, SAID TODAY.

MR. LIN WAS COMMENTING ON A RECENT COURT CASE IN WHICH AN EMPLOYER ENGAGED IN THE CONTAINER BUSINESS WAS FINED \$500 PLUS \$250 IN COST BY A TSUEN WAN MAGISTRATE FOR DISMISSING A WORKER WHO WAS INJURED WHILE AT WORK AND WAS STILL ON SICK LEAVE.

HE POINTED OUT THAT THE DISMISSAL CONSTITUTED AN OFFENCE AGAINST SECTION 48 OF THE WORKMEN'S COMPENSATION ORDINANCE.

THE ORDINANCE STIPULATES THAT AN EMPLOYER SHALL NOT, WITHOUT THE CONSENT OF THE COMMISSIONER FOR LABOUR, TERMINATE THE CONTRACT OF SERVICE OR APPRENTICESHIP OF A WORKMAN WHO HAS SUFFERED INCAPACITY IN CIRCUMSTANCES WHICH ENTITLE HIM TO WORKMEN'S COMPENSATION, UNTIL EITHER THE WORKMAN HAS BEEN CERTIFIED BY A MEDICAL PRACTITIONER AS FIT TO RESUME WORK, OR COMPENSATION FOR PERMANENT INCAPACITY BECOMES PAYABLE TO THE WORKMAN.

+AN EMPLOYER WHO CONTRAVENES THIS SECTION SHALL BE GUILTY OF AN OFFENCE AND SHALL BE LIABLE ON CONVICTION TO A MAXIMUM FINE OF \$2,000,+ MR. LIN ADDED.

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## SUMMER COURSES FOR SCIENCE TEACHERS

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TWO SUMMER COURSES FOR IN-SERVICE SCIENCE TEACHERS ON JUNIOR SECONDARY SCIENCE WILL START ON MONDAY (JULY 11) AT NORTHCOTE COLLEGE OF EDUCATION, BONHAM ROAD ANNEXE.

THESE COURSES, ORGANISED BY THE ADVISORY INSPECTORATE OF THE EDUCATION DEPARTMENT, AIM AT ACQUAINTING THE PARTICIPATING TEACHERS WITH APPROACHES TO AND METHODS OF TEACHING THE SCIENCE SYLLABUS AT FORMS 1-3 LEVEL.

THE FIRST COURSE RUNS FROM JULY 11 TO JULY 21, AND THE SECOND COURSE FROM AUGUST 17 TO AUGUST 26. 380 TEACHERS WILL ATTEND THE COURSES IN VARIOUS COLLEGES OF EDUCATION AND SECONDARY SCHOOLS.

THE CHIEF INSPECTOR OF SCHOOLS, MR. AUTHUR BROWN WILL GIVE THE OPENING ADDRESS.

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EXHIBITION ON PREVENTING GASTRO-INTESTINAL DISEASES

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A HEALTH EDUCATION EXHIBITION ON THE PREVENTION OF GASTRO-INTESTINAL DISEASES WILL BE HELD IN KOWLOON AND ON HONG KONG ISLAND NEXT WEEK.

THE EVENT IS ORGANISED BY THE MEDICAL AND HEALTH DEPARTMENT AS PART OF ITS ANNUAL HEALTH EDUCATION PROGRAMME.

THE EXHIBITION WILL FIRST BE HELD AT THE KWUN TONG COMMUNITY CENTRE, TSUI PING ROAD, KWUN TONG ON MONDAY AND TUESDAY (JULY 11 AND 12). IT WILL THEN MOVE TO THE WESTERN DISTRICT COMMUNITY CENTRE, WESTERN STREET, HONG KONG ON THURSDAY AND FRIDAY (JULY 14 AND 15).

THE EXHIBITION AT THE TWO PLACES WILL BE OPEN FROM 10 A.M. TO 4 P.M. DAILY. ALTHOUGH IT IS INTENDED FOR SCHOOL CHILDREN, MEMBERS OF THE GENERAL PUBLIC WILL ALSO BE WELCOME.

ITEMS ON DISPLAY WILL INCLUDE PICTURES, DIAGRAMS AND CHARTS ILLUSTRATING THE CAUSES OF SUCH GASTRO-INTESTINAL DISEASES AS TYPHOID FEVER, DYSENTERY, FOOD POISONING, AND HEPATITIS WHICH ARE PREVALENT IN THE WARMER MONTHS, AND WAYS TO PREVENT THEM.

THERE WILL ALSO BE FILM SHOWS ON PERSONAL AND FOOD HYGIENE.

A SPOKESMAN FOR THE DEPARTMENT SAID THE INCIDENCE OF GASTRO-INTESTINAL DISEASES HAS REMAINED NORMAL SO FAR THIS YEAR. HOWEVER, HE ADVISED THE PUBLIC TO TAKE ALL PRECAUTIONARY MEASURES TO PREVENT POSSIBLE OUTBREAKS IN THE SUMMER SEASON.

HE REMINDED THAT IT IS STRICTLY NECESSARY TO OBSERVE THE RULES OF PERSONAL HYGIENE AND ENVIRONMENTAL CLEANLINESS, WHICH ARE THE MOST EFFECTIVE METHOD OF PREVENTING SUMMER DISEASES, INCLUDING CHOLERA.

+THIS IS PARTICULARLY IMPORTANT WHEN WE ARE IN THE MIDST OF WATER RESTRICTIONS,+ HE SAID.

THE SPOKESMAN ADVISED THAT FOOD MUST BE THOROUGHLY COOKED BEFORE CONSUMPTION, AND WATER SHOULD BE BOILED BEFORE DRINKING.
