DB MEMBERS VISIT VIETNAMESE CENTRES

SIX CENTRAL AND WESTERN DISTRICT BOARD MEMBERS VISITED THREE VIETNAMESE REFUGEES AND BOAT PEOPLE CENTRES THIS (TUESDAY) MORNING.

ARRANGED BY THE REFUGEES DIVISION OF THE SECURITY BRANCH, THE VISIT COVERED THE SHAM SHUI PO DETENTION CENTRE, THE SAN YICK CLOSED CENTRE AND THE PILLAR POINT VIETNAMESE REFUGEES CENTRE.

THE VISIT WAS ARRANGED IN VIEW OF DISTRICT BOARD MEMBERS' GRAVE CONCERN ABOUT THE BOAT PEOPLE PROBLEM.

THE PARTY WAS ACCOMPANIED ON THE VISIT BY THE DISTRICT OFFICER, MR STEPHEN FISHER, AND A SENIOR EXECUTIVE OFFICER FROM THE REFUGEES DIVISION, MR YUEN LEUNG-FAI.

A "HOME SECURITY AND ANTI-CORRUPTION DAY CAMP" FOR RESIDENTS OF WONG TAI SIN WILL BE HELD AT THE LEI YUE MUN PARK HOLIDAY CAMP ON SEPTEMBER 3.

THE CAMP IS JOINTLY ORGANISED BY THE WONG TAI SIN DISTRICT FIGHT CRIME COMMITTEE, THE KOWLOON CENTRAL OFFICE OF THE INDEPENDENT COMMISSION AGAINST CORRUPTION AND THE WONG TAI SIN POLICE COMMUNITY RELATIONS OFFICE.

SPONSORSHIP IS BEING PROVIDED BY THE DISTRICT OFFICE AND DISTRICT BOARD.

BETTER MANAGEMENT OF TUEN MUN ROAD URGED

THE TRAFFIC AND TRANSPORT COMMITTEE OF THE TUEN MUN DISTRICT BOARD WILL DISCUSS, AT ITS MEETING TOMORROW (WEDNESDAY), A PAPER SUBMITTED BY SEVERAL MEMBERS REQUESTING BETTER MANAGEMENT OF TUEN MUN ROAD.

IN RESPONSE TO REPORTS MADE BY SOME PROFESSIONAL DRIVERS THAT THE WINDSCREENS OF THEIR VEHICLES HAD BEEN DAMAGED BY SAND AND STONES FLYING FROM THE ROAD SURFACE WHILE DRIVING ON TUEN MUN ROAD, THE MEMBERS HAVE CALLED FOR STEPPED UP EFFORTS TO KEEP THE ROAD CLEAN.

THE MEETING WILL ALSO DISCUSS THE PROVISION OF PUBLIC TRANSPORT SERVICES IN AREAS WHERE REFUGEE CENTRES ARE LOCATED.

THREE PAPERS ON THE SETTING UP OF A TAXI STAND, A BUS STOP AND A TEMPORARY CARPARK FOR LORRIES IN SEVERAL PARTS OF THE DISTRICT, THE PROGRESS REPORT OF THE COMMITTEE AND THE TRANSPORT DEPARTMENT REPORT WILL BE TABLED.

TENDERS INVITED FOR CONSTRUCTION OF DRAINAGE CHANNELS

THE CIVIL ENGINEERING SERVICES DEPARTMENT IS INVITING TENDERS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF DRAINAGE CHANNELS NEAR HUNG SHUI KIU IN YUEN LONG TO REDUCE FLOOD HAZARDS IN THE SURROUNDING AREA.

WORKS UNDER THE CONTRACT INCLUDE THE CONSTRUCTION OF CONCRETE-LINED CHANNELS, ASSOCIATED ACCESS ROADS, FOOTBRIDGES, CYCLE TRACKS AND FOOTPATHS, AND RECONSTRUCTION OF THE EXISTING CROSSINGS OVER THE CHANNEL.

CONSTRUCTION WORK IS EXPECTED TO COMMENCE IN NOVEMBER THIS YEAR AND TAKE ABOUT 30 MONTHS TO COMPLETE.

TENDERS SHOULD BE SUBMITTED BEFORE NOON ON SEPTEMBER 1.

ILLEGAL STRUCTURES IN SHEUNG WAN TO BE DEMOLISHED

THE BUILDING AUTHORITY IS TO SEEK THE CLOSURE OF UNAUTHORISED BUILDING WORKS IN SHEUNG WAN, SO THAT THEY CAN BE DEMOLISHED WITHOUT DANGER TO THE OCCUPIERS OR TO THE PUBLIC.

THE STRUCTURES ARE LOCATED AT FLAT B, FIRST FLOOR, PO WAN BUILDING, 6 TAI PING SHAN STREET.

THE CLOSURE IS PART OF AN EXERCISE TO ENFORCE AN ORDER ISSUED UNDER THE BUILDINGS ORDINANCE ON DECEMBER 14, 1985, REQUIRING THE DEMOLITION OF THESE UNAUTHORISED BUILDING WORKS.

NOTICE OF INTENTION TO APPLY FOR CLOSURE ORDERS FROM THE HONG KONG DISTRICT COURT ON SEPTEMBER 26 THIS YEAR WAS POSTED ON A CONSPICUOUS PART OF THE STRUCTURES TODAY (TUESDAY).

IT IS INTENDED THAT THE DEMOLITION WORK WILL BE CARRIED OUT ONCE THE CLOSURE ORDER IS OBTAINED.
